

TOONS Classes Supply list.

- Sketch pad 9x12 Spiral bound/100pgs
- Trace pad 9x12
- brushes. Get short, , synthetic brushes in round shapes for acrylic use
 - Try to get several sizes from very small to medium. Our kit has 3 brushes
- ink H2O proof
- Mars white eraser
- Mechanical pencil w/2B lead
- Drawing pencil 4B
- 2 fine (F) black PITT pens.
- 2 superfine (S) black PITT pens.
- 1 pad FANBOY cartooning layout pages
- 1 pad FANBOY **Comic Book** art boards
- drafting tape
- 24 (or more) set of Prismacolor student or professional grade colored pencils
Do not get a cheap set! Our kit has the student grade called “Scholar” prismacolors.
- Set of watercolor paints. Anything will work. Student grade tubes are best, though. See the watercolor supply list below.
- 1 pad Velum Bristol paper 9 x 12.

Watercolor paint list

••• 9 tubes of watercolor paints. You should stay away from pigments with Cadmium or Cobalt since they are toxic heavy metals. The HUE version of these colors just mimic the pigments and don't have the expensive, toxic metals in them so they're ok. Winsor paints are great, but their Cotman brand will work for learning and is much cheaper. Our kit uses Cotman.

1. Cadmium Yellow pale HUE or similar (azo yellow or a hue)
2. Cadmium Red medium HUE or similar (naphthol red or a hue)
3. Alizarin Crimson
4. Winsor Green blue shade (pthalo green)
5. Winsor Purple
6. Cerulean Blue or Manganese Blue
7. French Ultramarine or prussian blue
8. Burnt Umber
9. Raw Sienna

••• A good large plastic palette with little cubbies around the sides for paint and several mixing areas in the middle. I like to have dividers in the middle to make 4 or 6 mixing areas.

••• An eye dropper or baby nose bulb for moving water easily.
